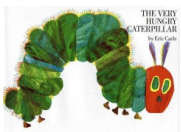


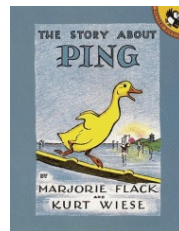
I'm Killing Summer Reading: Lower Grades

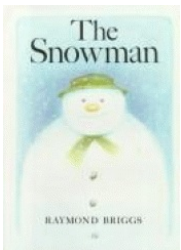

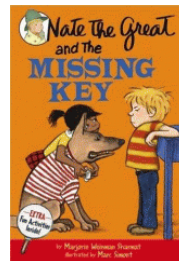
The very hungry caterpillar

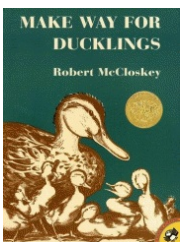
The story about Ping

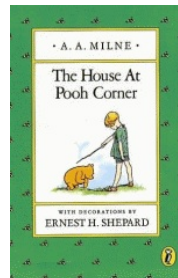
