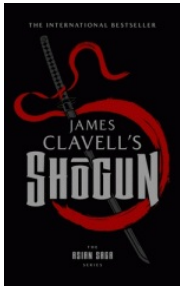

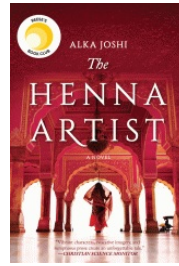


## Shogun : The Epic Novel of Japan

were to change his life: a warlord with his own quest f...

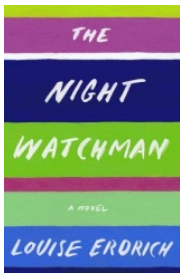


## The Henna Artist
