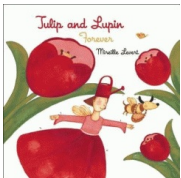


# How Children Can Learn About Death/Separation

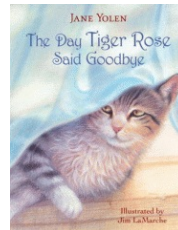
