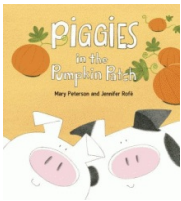


Baby and Toddler Storytime @ Milliken Mills, Nov 16th: Phonological Awareness / I Hear Words!

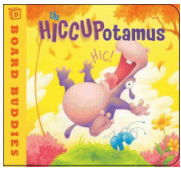

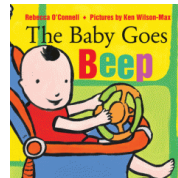

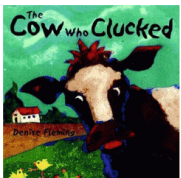
