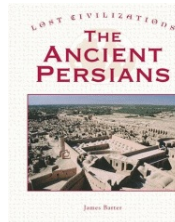

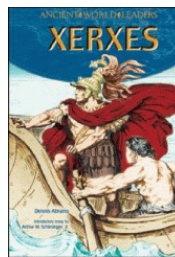

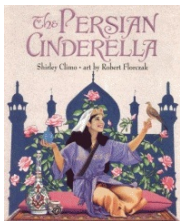

Objective: Students will be able to explain what the Silk Road is and how it contributed to the diffusion of goods, people, and culture across Eurasia.



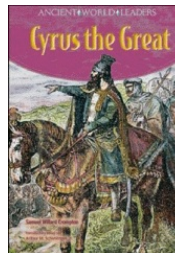

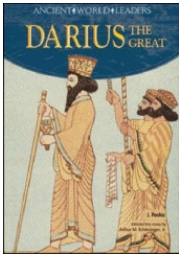

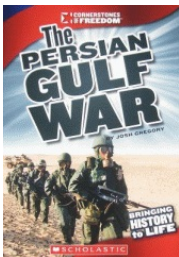
