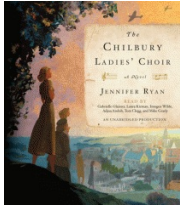

to shutter the church's choir in the absence of men and instead carry on singing.

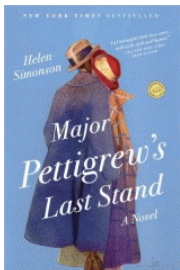


Miss Buncle's book

out.

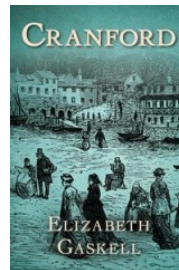


Major Pettigrew's last stand

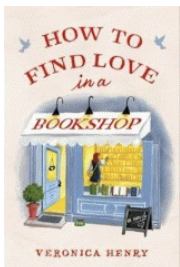

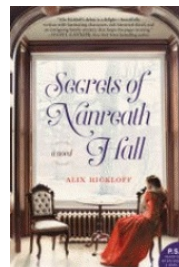


How to find love in a bookshop

Secrets of Nanreath Hall

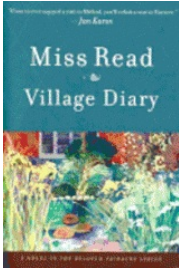
