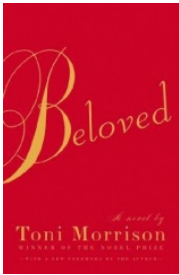


Bklyn BookMatch: Magic Realism and the Fantastic

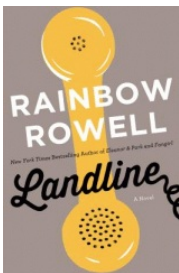

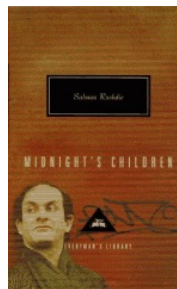

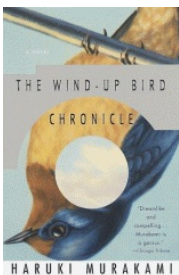
