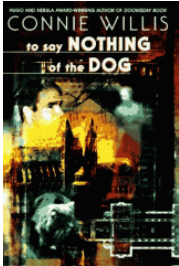


Alex Award Winners

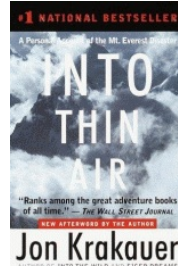

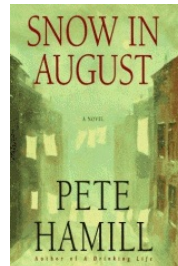

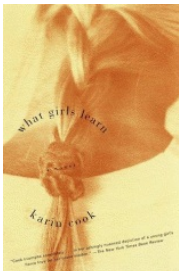

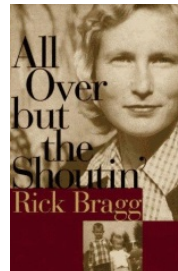

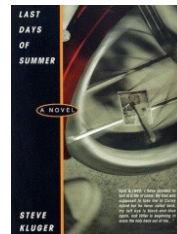
