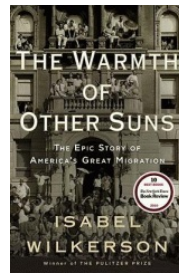


Empire of the summer moon

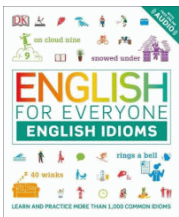

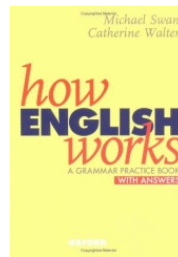
