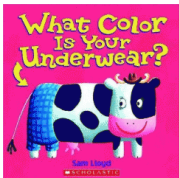


Baby/Toddler Storytime: I <3 to SING!

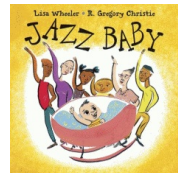
