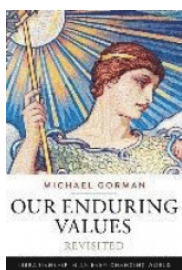


# BKLYN BookMatch: Library & Information Science

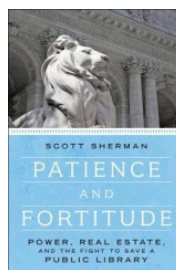

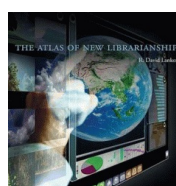
