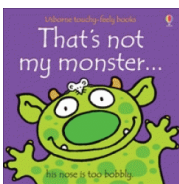


Baby/Toddler Storytime @ Milliken Mills - Letter Knowledge / I Know Letters!

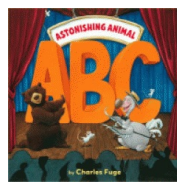

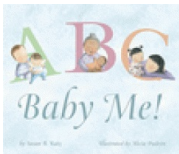

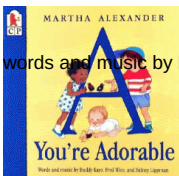
