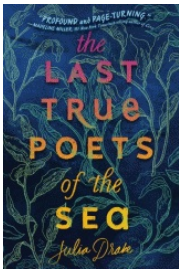

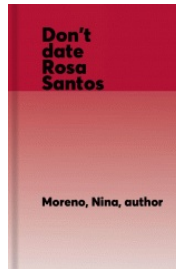


## The last true poets of the sea

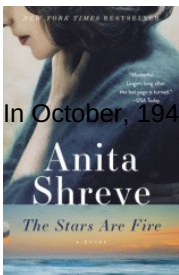
and for answers about her family's long struggle with mental illness, all while falling in...
