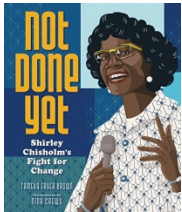


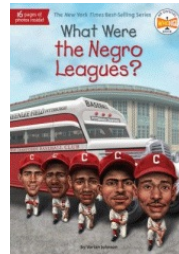
Black Heritage Stamp Series

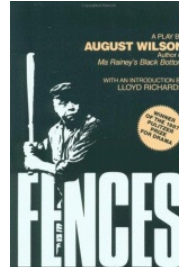
