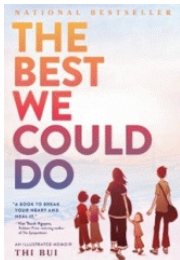

Bui, Thi, author, artist.

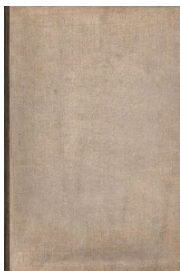
Bui describes her experiences as a young Vietnamese immigrant, highlighting her family's move from their war-torn home to the United States in graphic novel format.

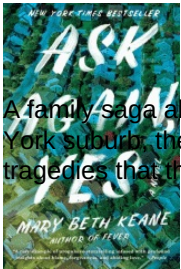
