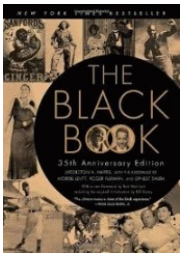

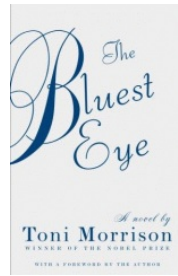

Harris, M. A., 1908-1977.

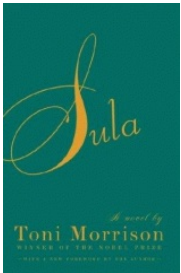
An anthology of photographs, illustrations, essays, and other documents of black life in the United States from the time of slavery to the 1970s published during Morrison's time at Random House.

Morrison, Toni.

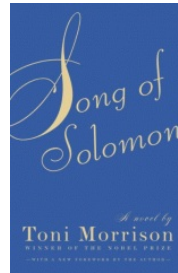

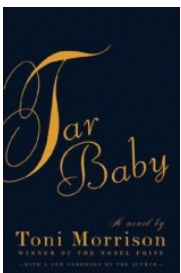

Toni Morrison's second novel--a magnificent if unsparing novel depicting female friendship.



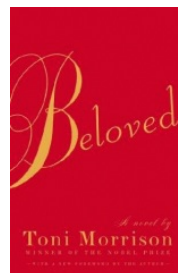
