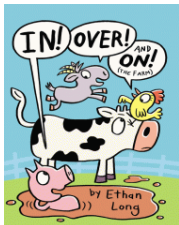

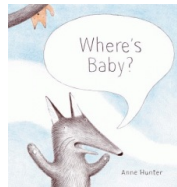

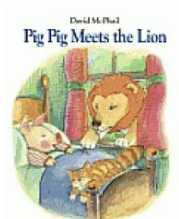
(Book) Four farmyard friends illustrate prepositional phrases as they go in and out, over and under, around, on and off.

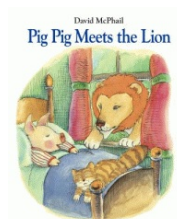
(Book) Papa Fox has to look everywhere for Baby, including inside the hole, under the water, over the hill, and more.

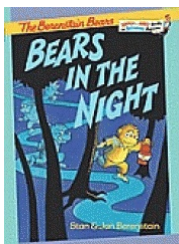

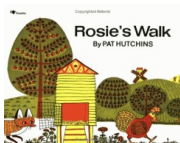

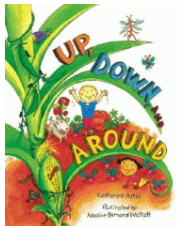
(Board book) Dinner's ready, but Spot is nowhere to be found! Help his mother by searching throughout the house.
