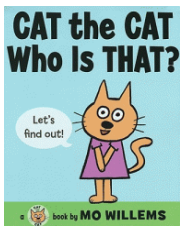


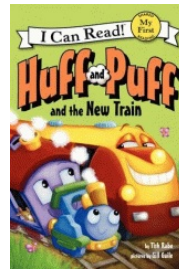
Bklyn BookMatch: Books for a beginner reader and books to read together

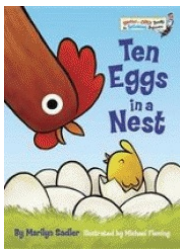

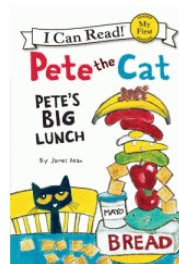

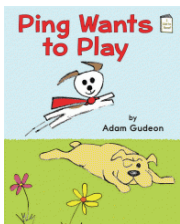
Huff and Puff and the new train

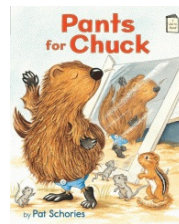
Ten eggs in a nest

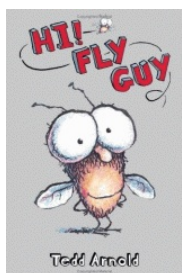

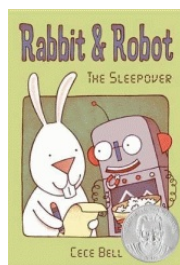
I broke my trunk!
