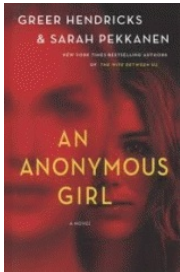

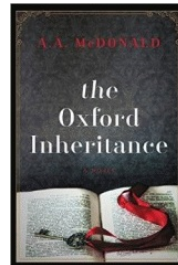

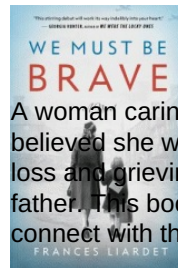

Miller, Sue,&#x1C2;d1943- author.

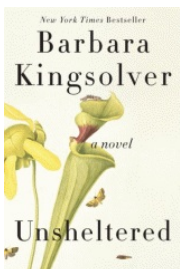

Liardet, Frances, author.

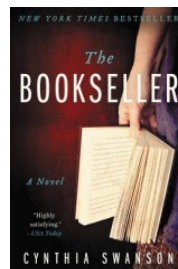

Cynthia Swanson.

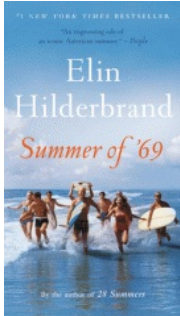
