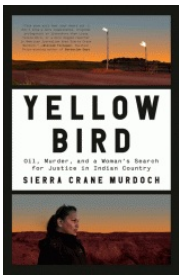

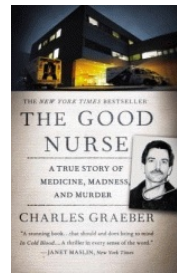


Yellow Bird : oil, murder, and a woman's search for justice in Indian country

oil boom. In her absence, the landscape had been altered beyond recognition, her tribal government swayed by corporate interests, and her commu...

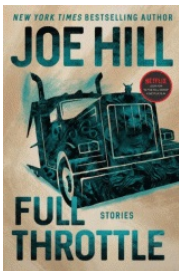


The good nurse

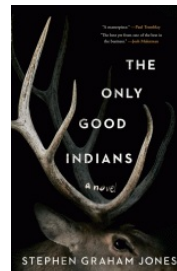

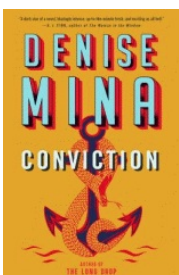


The only good Indians : a novel

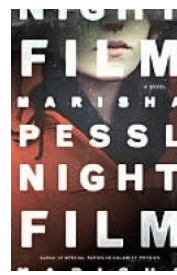

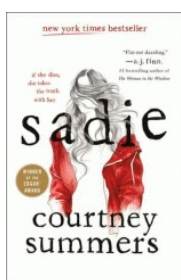
