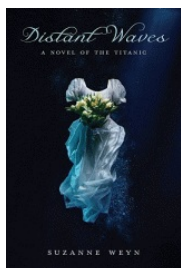


MPL: Titanic (sank April 15, 1812)

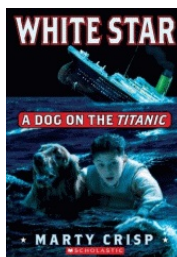

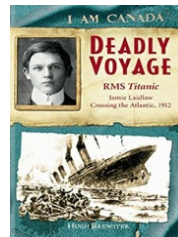
