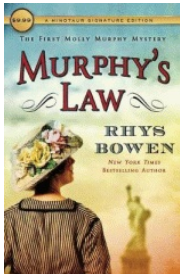

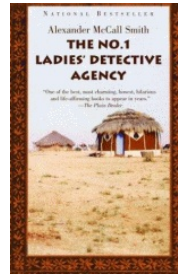

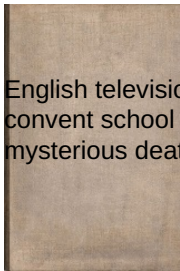

## The No. 1 Ladies' Detective Agency

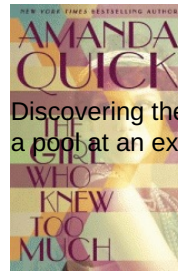
Alexander McCall Smith.

## Quiet as a nun.

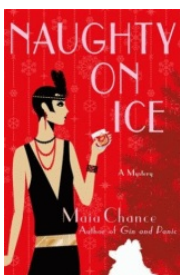
